Dear Friend,

The City of San Rafael is pleased to partner with the Terra Linda Homeowners Association to make significant improvements to the North portion of Freitas Park located on Monticello Avenue in the Terra Linda neighborhood of San Rafael.

The small site currently is underutilized due to the lack of community serving amenities. The TLHOA surveyed residents, met with City officials and proposed a professionally developed design to make the park more visually appealing and interesting to users.

The Park and Recreation Commission at their meeting on February 16, 2017 agreed to enter into a public private partnership with the Association to coordinate fund raising and volunteer resources for the achievement of the primary goals of the design: improved seating and picnic furnishings, enhanced landscape maintenance, and installation of a labyrinth meditation feature.

The result will create an environment conducive to quiet activity, contemplation and relaxation to compliment the very active children's play areas in the South portion of Freitas Park, the bustle of the Kaiser Permanente campus across the street, and the daily ebb and flow of Vallecito Elementary and Mark Day School campuses in the area.

The City and Association have produced two such cooperative park projects in recent years, proving a record of success working together.
